# 2015 HIGHLIGHTS

**LAST YEAR, OUR COASTAL EMPIRE COMMUNITY CAME TOGETHER, CREATING OPPORTUNITIES FOR WONDERFUL LIVES FOR ALL.**

**31,000 DONORS MOBILIZED**  
to exceed our Campaign goal, raising more than \$9 million.

**3,000 INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES**  
moved toward financial stability in Effingham County through services such as tax preparation, job skills training, disability job placement, transportation assistance, GED prep classes, birth certificates and Georgia IDs, and legal counseling.

**7,000 BRYAN COUNTY RESIDENTS**  
received weekly food assistance through partnering programs delivering well-balanced meals to seniors and persons with disabilities, supplying backpacks of food to children for the weekend during the school year, and stocking emergency food pantries.

**6,500 VOLUNTEERS ENGAGED**  
in reading to children, delivering food to homebound seniors, renovating homes and buildings, cleaning the beach and parks, and other projects orchestrated through United Way HandsOn Savannah.

**44,000 NUTRITIOUS MEALS**  
and snacks provided by the Backpack Buddy program to overcome weekend food insecurity in Liberty County.

**10,000 CALLERS CONNECTED**  
with much-needed assistance for housing and shelter, financial services, and mental health and substance abuse counseling resources through the United Way 2-1-1 referral service. An additional 4,000 visitors connected to services via 2-1-1's website.

**3,000 STUDENTS**  
received early childhood literacy books through Read Across Liberty.

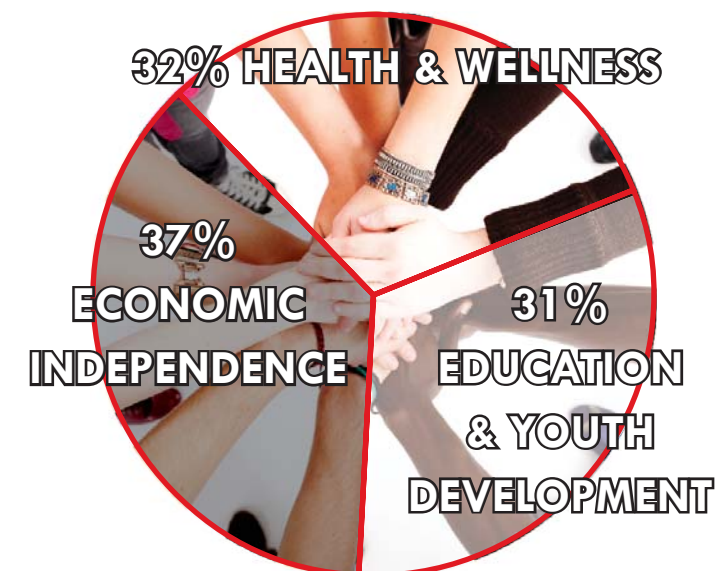

Follow Sam's journey from crisis to success. Through the work of United Way agencies, his life, and the lives of those around him are supported, encouraged, and improved.



Sam and his family find hope in their fight against hunger and homelessness in the care of soup kitchens and an emergency shelter.



Access to early education programs allows Sam to keep up, stay prepared, and move along the right path in school despite his stressful home life.



Sam's grandfather is diagnosed with diabetes. Grandpa Joe receives free prescription medication to help manage his chronic disease.



New job opportunities stabilize Sam's home after his parents receive guidance and assistance to complete job training and GED programs.



Sam's sister Andi learns healthy lifestyle choices and begins to imagine her future during after-school programs.



Grandma Rose is able to age successfully in her home using in-home nursing and meal deliveries.



Financial education equips Sam's parents to turn dreams into achievable plans.



Following a painful separation, Sam's best friend Ruby happily reunites with her parents with the help of counseling sessions and intervention programs.



Sam's teacher finds the strength to return to work after she spends time in a safe shelter and is given assistance to legally separate from her abusive spouse.

# COMMUNITYACHIEVEMENTS

For thousands of “Sams” and their families, life is a journey from problem to solution, crisis to success. At every turn, United Way and our partners are there to lift them up and create a better community for all.

Here are just a few examples of the great work done by our funded agencies last year.



## EDUCATION & YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

### SCHOOL READINESS

**1,700 CHILDREN**, 0-5 years old, attended early learning programs that monitor developmental milestones and provide needed interventions.

**92% OF CHILDREN** demonstrated improved social, emotional, language, cognitive, and physical skills.

### ACADEMIC SUCCESS

**96% OF CHILDREN** and youth advanced to the next grade level/graduated on time.

**87% OF CHILDREN** and youth demonstrated improved academic performance during the school year.

### YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

**10,000 CHILDREN** participated in after-school programs that provide a safe, structured environment.

**87% OF STUDENTS** increased job-related and/or soft skills.

## ECONOMIC INDEPENDENCE

### BASIC NEEDS

**177,200 MEALS** were provided to the hungry and homeless and 14,000 others received bags of groceries.

**60,000 NIGHTS** of emergency shelter and accommodations were provided to 2,000 homeless and displaced individuals.

### FINANCIAL CAPABILITY

**6,500 INDIVIDUALS** attended 400 financial literacy classes.

**4,500 FINANCIALLY STRESSED** individuals received one-on-one counseling on budgeting, money management and credit issues; 70% increased budgeting skills.

### EMPLOYMENT STABILITY

**680 UNEMPLOYED** or underemployed individuals completed a job training program.

**450 ADULT LEARNERS**, individuals without GEDs, and adults with learning disabilities made progress towards their education goals.

## HEALTH & WELLNESS

### DISEASE MANAGEMENT & PREVENTION

**3,700 PATIENTS** with a chronic disease received nearly \$12M in free or discounted prescription medications.

**93% OF ADULTS** at-risk for chronic disease improved preventive health behavior.

**1,200 PATIENTS** with a chronic disease improved clinical outcomes through disease management.

### KEEPING CHILDREN SAFE

**140 CHILDREN** were provided more than 6,300 nights of safe shelter and accommodations.

**6,000 COUNSELING SESSIONS** were provided to improve family relationships and support reunification.

### EMPOWERING VICTIMS

**20,000 NIGHTS** of safe shelter and accommodations were provided to more than 1,000 survivors of domestic violence and their dependent children.

**190 SURVIVORS** were assisted in separating from their abusive partners.

### LIVING INDEPENDENCE

**130,000 MEALS** were delivered to 800 homebound seniors.

**1,500 HOME** modifications, safety repairs, and assistive devices were provided at low- or no-cost.

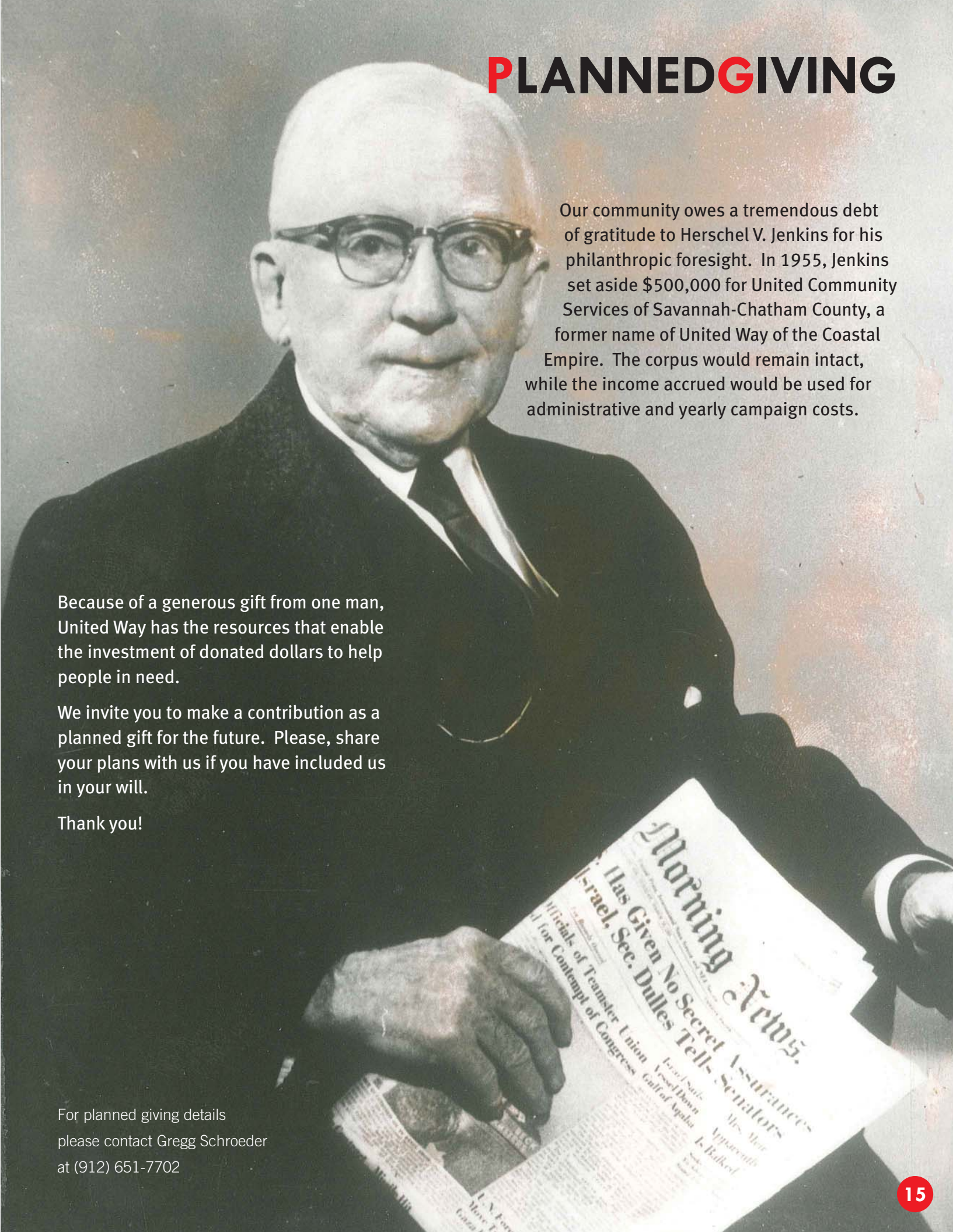
