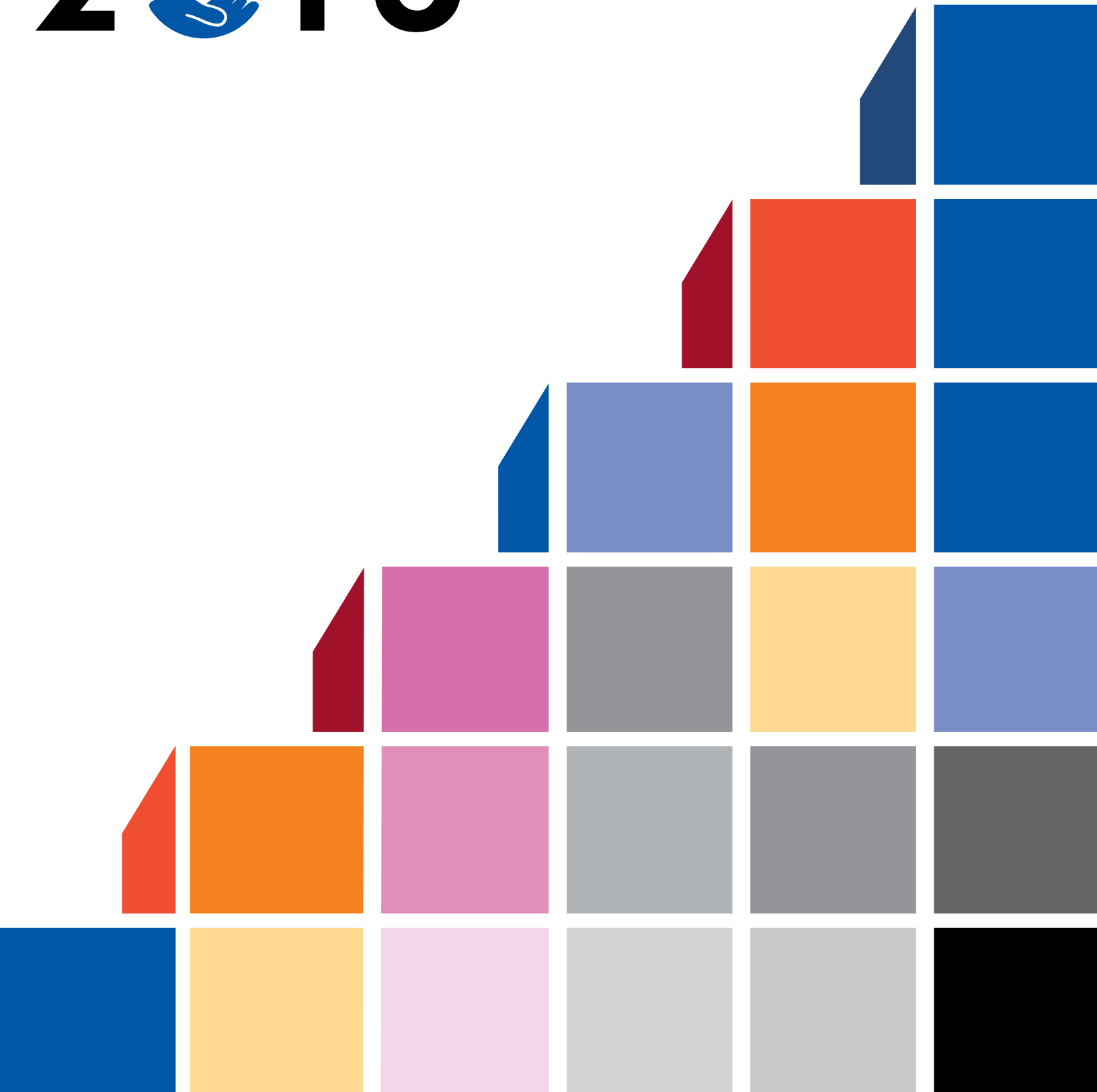

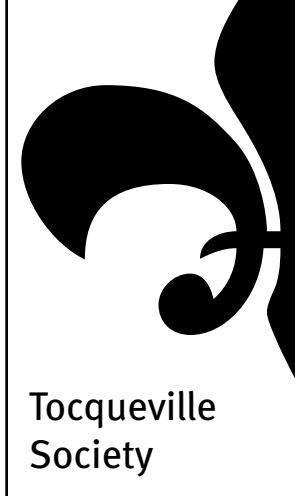

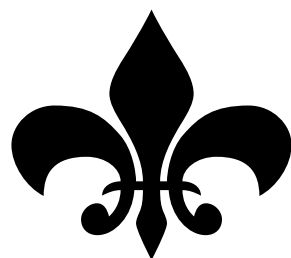


CHARLES

By the time most people reach 52 years of age, they give up on making sweeping life changes. Not Charles! Charles could not read. He was homeless, jobless, and recovering from addiction. He ended up in court for signing a contract that he couldn't read. The judge gave Charles an ultimatum, "Deal with the system or learn to read." He chose the latter.

His life is now coming together – a testament to his courage and perseverance and the compassion of a united community.

With support from Royce Learning Center, a United Way funded agency, Charles learned to read. He earned his driver license and has been living in his own apartment. He is gaining math and adaptive skills, like reading a menu. Most importantly, he has what all individuals wish for, the chance to build a brighter future.

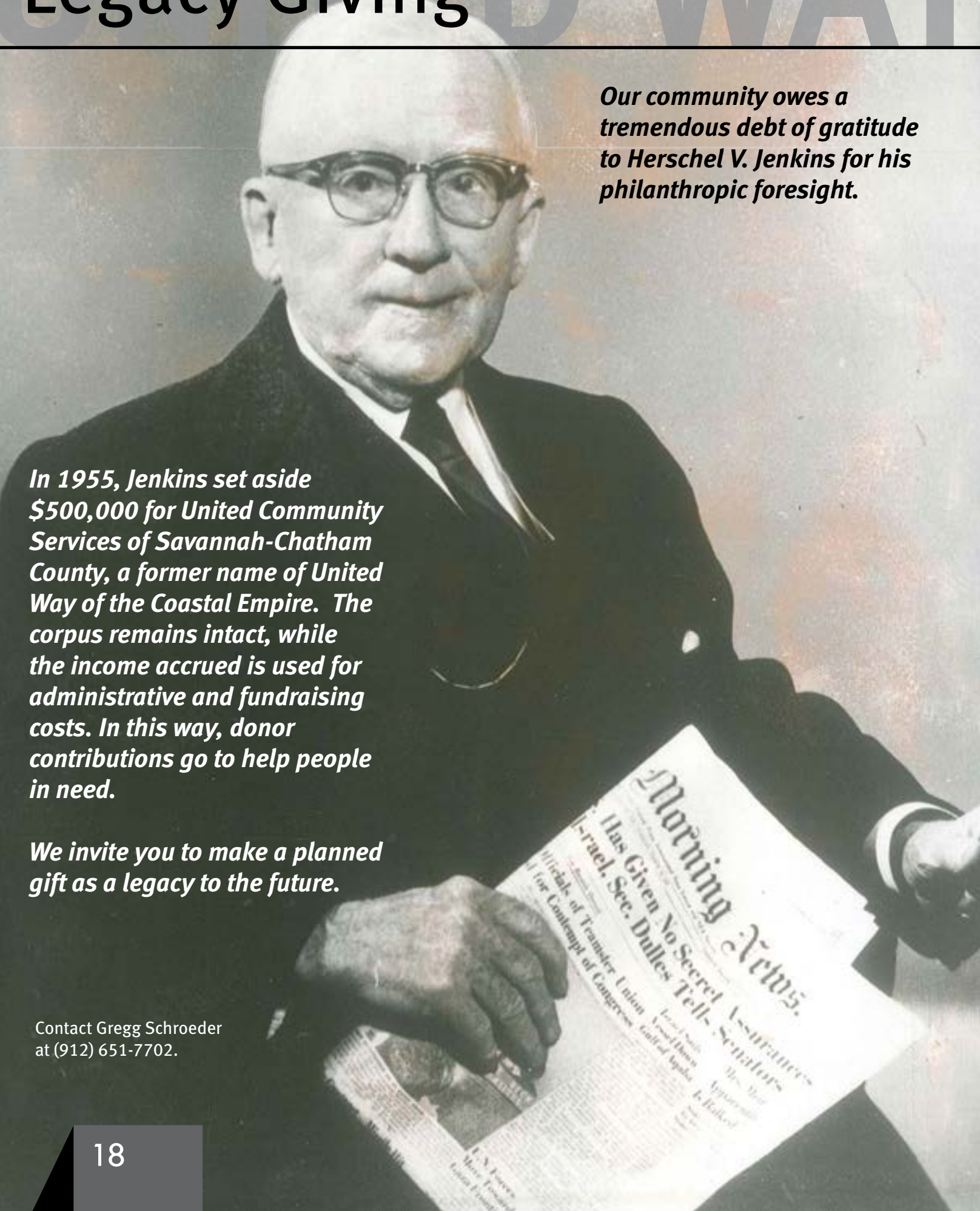

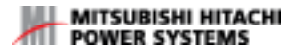
