ABOUT BENEFICIARIES



CURE Childhood Cancer's primary mission is to cure childhood cancer by directing funds to targeted research which is likely to have a positive impact on children within five years. In addition to financial assistance, CURE Childhood Cancer offers patients and families at Memorial Hospital weekly Open Arms meals, gas cards, lodging assistance, professional counseling, and bereavement care when needed.



Ronald McDonald House of the Coastal Empire allows families to remain close to their children while receiving treatment at our area hospitals and medical facilities. In 2018, they provided 4,400 family night stays to families. In addition, there are two Family Rooms at Memorial Health and St. Joseph's/Candler Hospital that in 2018 served 3,400 families providing necessary amenities so families could rest and regroup near their children.



The Lowcountry Annie Oakley's (LAO) Children's Fund is being established with United Way of the Coastal Empire to help children living with short and long term disabilities. From rehabilitation therapy, assistive vision and hearing technology, to early intervention scholarships, the LAO Children's Fund will ensure that children receive the individualized assistance needed to thrive. Services will be provided through the United Way 211 and the following collaborative partners: Abilities Unlimited, Faith Equestrian Therapeutic Center, EmployAbility, Kicklighter Resource Center, Living Independence for Everyone, The Matthew Reardon Center for Autism, Savannah Association for the Blind, Savannah Speech and Hearing.
